



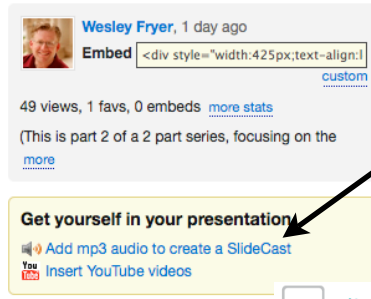
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Create a **SlideCast** to share a synchronized audio recording of your presentation with slides you have already uploaded to SlideShare.

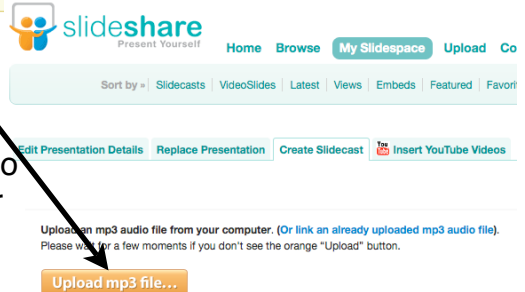
1 Make sure you are logged into SlideShare, and click on your previously uploaded presentation which you'd like to make into a SlideCast. Click **EDIT PRESENTATION** beside the title of your SlideShare presentation, or click **ADD MP3 AUDIO TO CREATE A SLIDECAST**.

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2 Click **UPLOAD MP3 FILE** to directly upload your recorded audio file to SlideShare. Make sure your MP3 file is encoded at a sample rate supported by Flash (44.1 khz, 22.05 khz or 11.025 khz) otherwise your audio will have the "chipmunk problem." Use iTunes, Switch, or another free audio conversion program to change your file's sample rate. Refer to www.slideshare.net/faqs/slidescast for details.

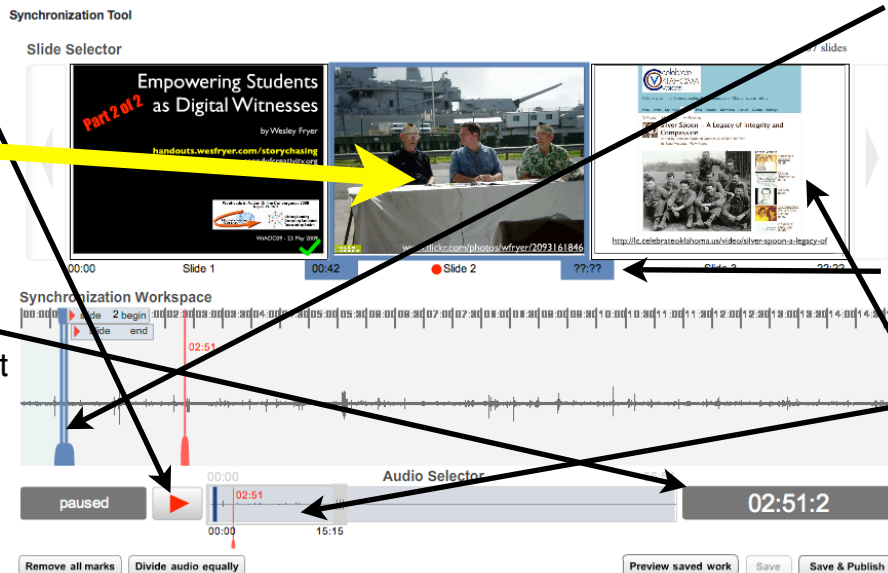


3 After your MP3 file finishes uploading and is processed / compressed, the slide synchronization interface/tool will appear. If you do not see the slide start and end markers (which are blue) use the tabs at the top to choose **EDIT PRESENTATION DETAILS** and click **UPDATE** after making a change. Then click again on the **EDIT SLIDECAST** tab.

Click the red **PLAY** button to start playback of your audio file

Click on the slide you want to sync (by defining the **END** marker.)

Watch the playhead time in the lower right corner and pause playback when you reach the time that slide should stop showing.



Drag the 2nd **BLUE** marker to the time when the slide should change. Watch the end mark time in the lower right corner of the slide.

Click on the next slide. Move the audio track window selector as needed. Click **SAVE & PUBLISH**.
